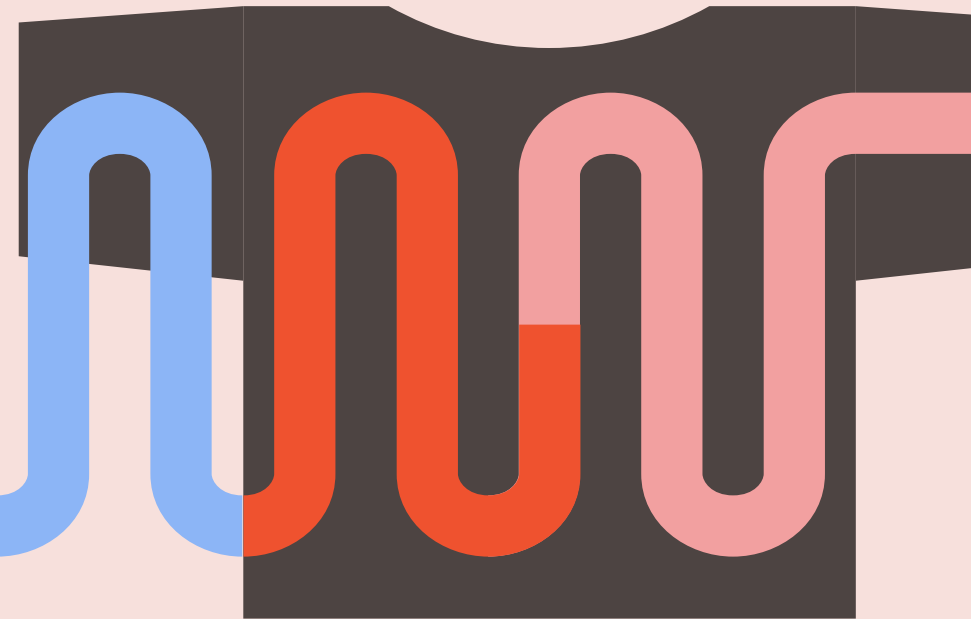
Gauge 28 st x 40 rows in 10 cm

Chest circ. of finished piece 120 cm

Length 52 cm (from neck side of shoulder slope)

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Front

Bottom section - Plain color

- Cast on 167 stitches using the 'e' wrap technique in background color ●
- Knit 22 rows with main bed carriage

Chart

- Change to intarsia carriage and reset the counter.

From here, all color pattern information will be written from right to left. When the carriage is on the left, read the row instructions backwards (starting and the end).

- **Row 1**
Knit 30 st ●, 9 st ●, 57 st ●, 9 st ●, 57 st ●, 5 st ●
- **Row 2** + 3 stitches on each side of the accent color section
Knit 27 st ●, 15 st ●, 51 st ●, 15 st ●, 51 st ●, 8 st ●
- **Row 3** + 2 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 25 st ●, 19 st ●, 47 st ●, 19 st ●, 47 st ●, 10 st ●
- **Row 4** + 2 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 23 st ●, 23 st ●, 43 st ●, 23 st ●, 43 st ●, 12 st ●
- **Row 5** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 22 st ●, 25 st ●, 41 st ●, 25 st ●, 41 st ●, 13 st ●
- **Row 6** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 21 st ●, 27 st ●, 39 st ●, 27 st ●, 39 st ●, 14 st ●
- **Row 7** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 20 st ●, 29 st ●, 37 st ●, 29 st ●, 37 st ●, 15 st ●

- **Row 8** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 19 st ●, 31 st ●, 35 st ●, 31 st ●, 35 st ●, 16 st ●
- **Row 9** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 18 st ●, 33 st ●, 33 st ●, 33 st ●, 33 st ●, 17 st ●
- **Row 10** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 17 st ●, 35 st ●, 31 st ●, 35 st ●, 31 st ●, 18 st ●
- **Row 11** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 16 st ●, 37 st ●, 29 st ●, 37 st ●, 29 st ●, 19 st ●
- **Row 12** Knit as row 11
- **Row 13** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 15 st ●, 39 st ●, 27 st ●, 39 st ●, 27 st ●, 20 st ●
- **Row 14** Knit as row 13
- **Row 15** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 14 st ●, 41 st ●, 25 st ●, 41 st ●, 25 st ●, 21 st ●
- **Row 16** Knit as row 15
- **Row 17** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 13 st ●, 43 st ●, 23 st ●, 43 st ●, 23 st ●, 22 st ●
- **Row 18** Knit as row 17
- **Row 19** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 12 st ●, 45 st ●, 21 st ●, 45 st ●, 21 st ●, 23 st ●
- **Row 20 & 21** Knit as row 19
- **Row 22** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section
Knit 11 st ●, 47 st ●, 19 st ●, 47 st ●, 19 st ●, 24 st ●
- **Row 23 & 24** Knit as row 22

- **Row 25** + 1 st on each side of the accent color section

Knit 10 st ●, 49 st ●, 17 st ●, 49 st ●, 17 st ●, 25 st ●

- **Row 26** Knit as row 25

Add new yarns to split the accent color sections into two (see chart 1)

- **Row 27** - Knit 10 st ●, 22 st ●, 5 st ●, 22 st ●, 17 st ●, 22 st ●, 5 st ●, 22 st ●, 17 st ●, 22 st ●, 3 st ●
- **Row 28** - Knit 10 st ●, 20 st ●, 9 st ●, 20 st ●, 17 st ●, 20 st ●, 9 st ●, 20 st ●, 17 st ●, 20 st ●, 5 st ●
- **Row 29** - knit 10 st ●, 19 st ●, 11 st ●, 19 st ●, 17 st ●, 19 st ●, 11 st ●, 19 st ●, 17 st ●, 19 st ●, 6 st ●
- **Row 30** - knit 9 st ●, 20 st ●, 11 st ●, 20 st ●, 15 st ●, 20 st ●, 11 st ●, 20 st ●, 15 st ●, 20 st ●, 6 st ●
- **Row 31** - knit 9 st ●, 19 st ●, 13 st ●, 19 st ●, 15 st ●, 19 st ●, 13 st ●, 19 st ●, 15 st ●, 19 st ●, 7 st ●
- **Row 32 & 33** Knit as row 31
- **Row 34** - knit 8 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 9 st ●
- **Row 35 - 64** Knit as row 34

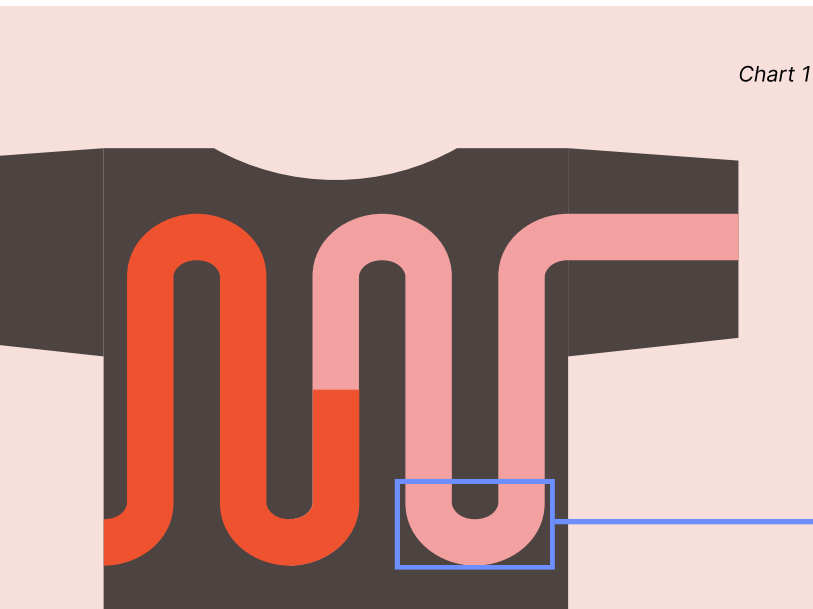
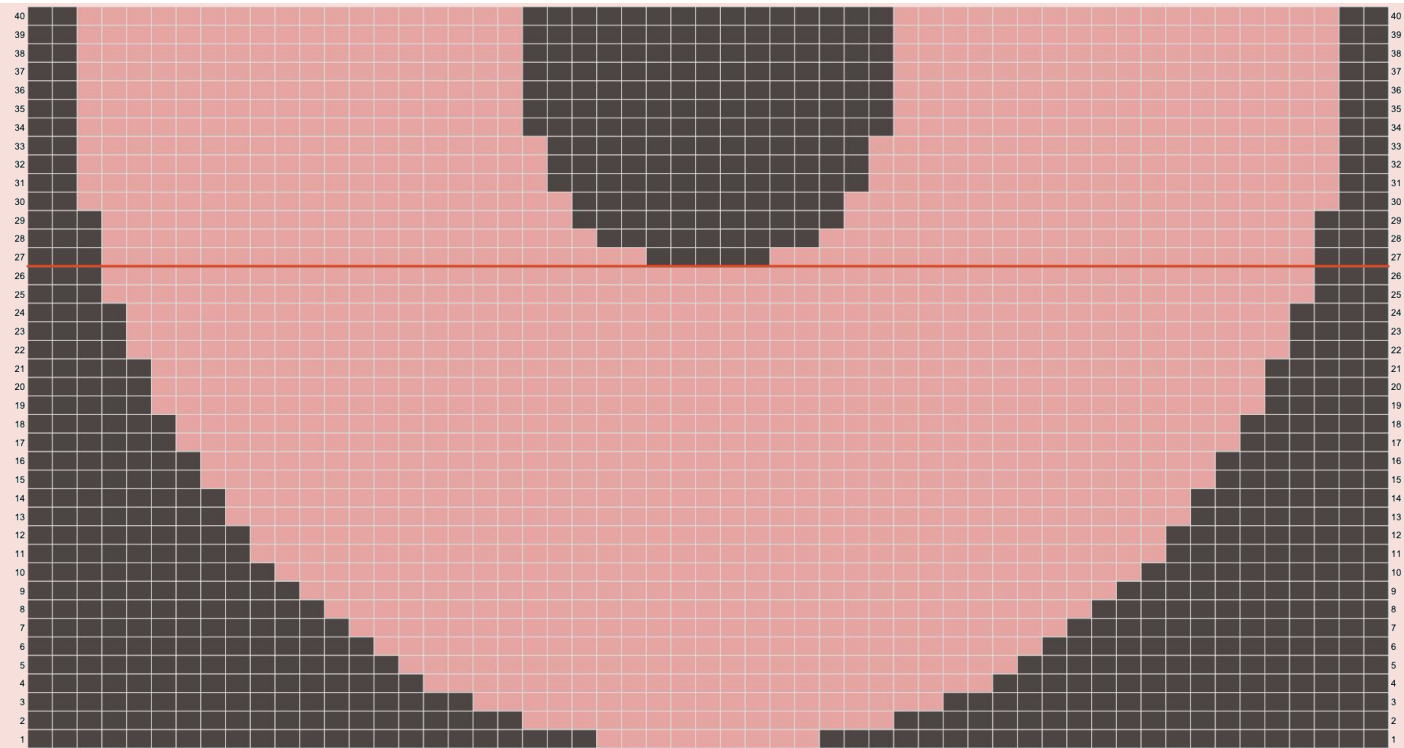

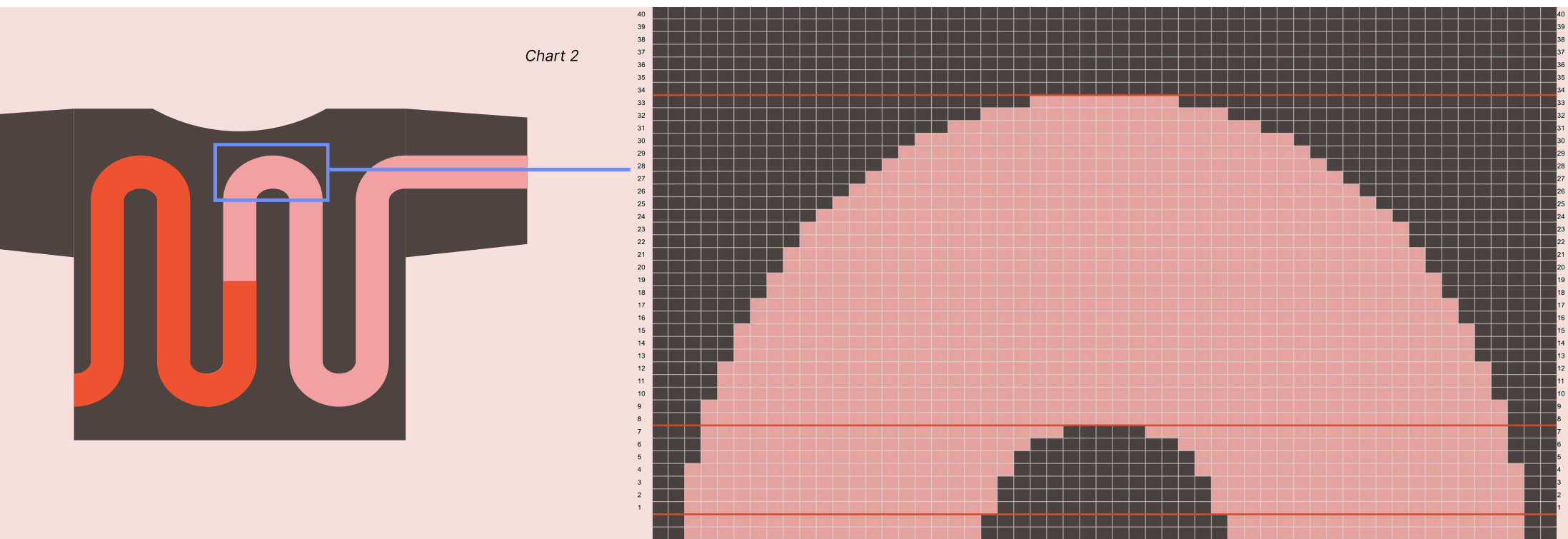
Change the color of the accent line in the middle column

- **Row 65** - knit 8 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 15 st ●, 18 st ●, 9 st ●
- **Row 66 - 108** Knit as row 65

Reset the counter to start closing the top curves (see chart 2).

- **Row 1** - knit 8 st ●, 19 st ●, 15 st ●, 19 st ●, 13 st ●, 19 st ●, 15 st ●, 19 st ●, 13 st ●, 19 st ●, 8 st ●
- **Row 2 & 3** Knit as row 1
- **Row 4** - knit 7 st ●, 20 st ●, 15 st ●, 20 st ●, 11 st ●, 20 st ●, 15 st ●, 20 st ●, 11 st ●, 20 st ●, 8 st ●
- **Row 5** - knit 7 st ●, 19 st ●, 17 st ●, 19 st ●, 11 st ●, 19 st ●, 17 st ●, 19 st ●, 11 st ●, 19 st ●, 9 st ●
- **Row 6** - Knit 6 st ●, 20 st ●, 17st ●, 20 st ●, 9 st ●, 20 st ●, 17 st ●, 20 st ●, 9 st ●, 20 st ●, 9 st ●
- **Row 7** - knit 4 st ●, 22 st ●, 17 st ●, 22 st ●, 5 st ●, 22 st ●, 17 st ●, 22 st ●, 5 st ●, 22 st ●, 9 st ●

Both sides of the curve of accent color will now merge into one block of color





- **Row 8**

Knit 26 st , 17 st , 49 st , 17 st , 49 st , 9 st 

- **Row 9** Knit as row 8

- **Row 10** -1 stitch on each side of the accent color section

knit 25 st , 19 st , 47 st , 19 st , 47 st , 10 st 

- **Row 11 & 12** Knit as row 10

- **Row 13** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 24 st , 21 st , 45 st , 21 st , 45 st , 11 st 

- **Row 14 & 15** Knit as row 13

- **Row 16** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 23 st , 23 st , 43 st , 23 st , 43 st , 12 st 

- **Row 17** Knit as row 16

- **Row 18** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 22 st , 25 st , 41 st , 25 st , 41 st , 13 st 

- **Row 19** Knit as row 18

- **Row 20** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 21 st , 27 st , 39 st , 27 st , 39 st , 14 st 

- **Row 21** Knit as row 20

- **Row 22** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 20 st , 29 st , 37 st , 29 st , 37 st , 15 st 

- **Row 23** Knit as row 22

- **Row 24** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 19 st , 31 st , 35 st , 31 st , 35 st , 16 st 

- **Row 25** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 18 st , 33 st , 33 st , 33 st , 33 st , 17 st 

- **Row 26** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 17 st , 35 st , 31 st , 35 st , 31 st , 18 st 

- **Row 27** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 16 st , 37 st , 29 st , 37 st , 29 st , 19 st 

- **Row 28** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 15 st , 39 st , 27 st , 39 st , 27 st , 20 st 

- **Row 29** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 14 st , 41 st , 25 st , 41 st , 25 st , 21 st 

- **Row 30** -1 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 13 st , 43 st , 23 st , 43 st , 23 st , 22 st 

- **Row 31** -2 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 11 st , 47 st , 19 st , 47 st , 19 st , 24 st 

- **Row 32** -2 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 9 st , 51 st , 15 st , 51 st , 15 st , 26 st 

- **Row 33** -3 st on each side of the accent color section

knit 6 st , 57 st , 9 st , 57 st , 9 st , 29 st 

Change back to default main bed carriage and keep only a background color  thread. Reset the counter

- Knit 19 rows

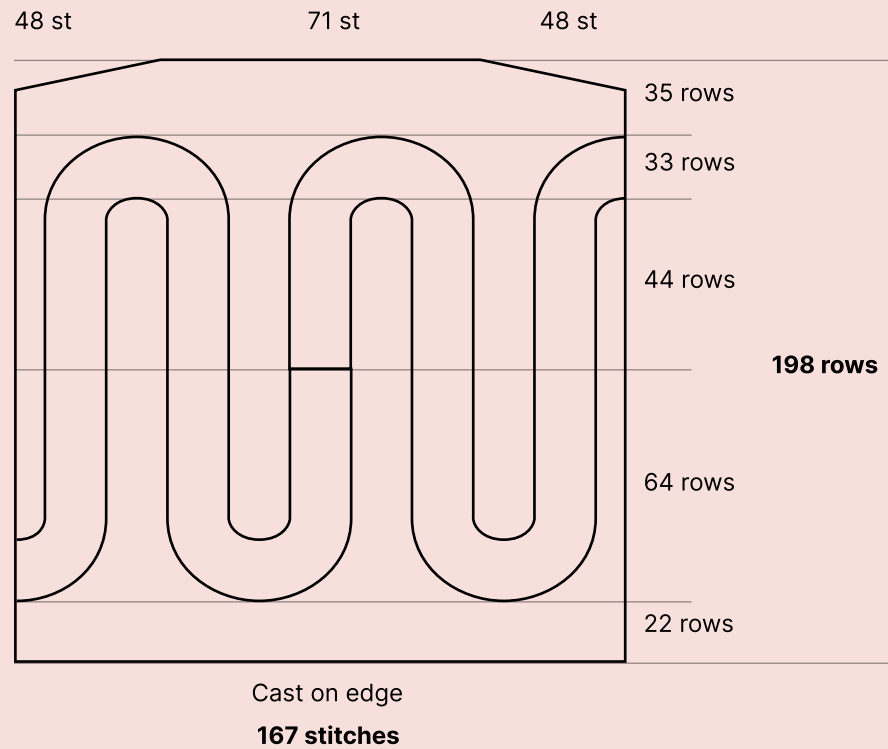
Shoulders

Start on the shoulder slope, shaping with short rows.

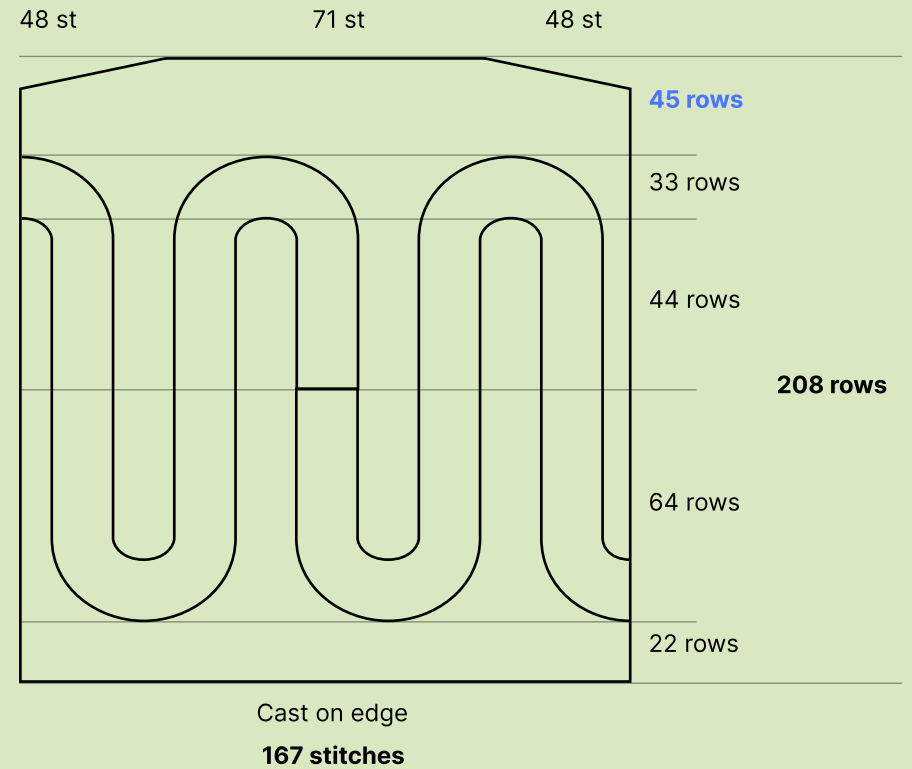
- Put 6 needles on hold -on the opposite side of the carriage- every other row, a total of 8 times. You are now on row 35
- Bring all needles back into working position
- Knit one more row
- Cast-off the front piece

Back

The back piece is knit just like the front with two main differences:

- The **accent color line is mirrored** (starts and ends in the opposite side than the front)
- There are **10 more rows** knitted on the top section before starting on the neck sloping (this has the same purpose as short rows, lifting the back of the neck, and lowering the front).

In the knitted sample, two different accent colors are used for the back.

As an example, the first row becomes, from right to left:

• Row 1

Knit 5 st ■, 57 st ■, 9 st ■, 57 st ■, 9 st ■, 30 st ■



(colors appear inverted from the instructions as this is the front view of the piece)

Sleeve 1

Sleeve with accent line continuations

- Cast on 96 stitches using the 'e' wrap technique in background color ■

Start with sleeve chart using intarsia carriage. From here, all color pattern information will be written from right to left. When the carriage is on the left, read the row instructions backwards (starting and the end).

• Row 1

Knit 21 st ■, 17 st ■, 20 st ■, 17 st ■, 21 st ■

Keep the accent color lines in the same column throughout. Remove 1 stitch on each side every 10 rows. Knit until row 68. There should be a total of 84 stitches.

• Row 68

Knit 15 st ■, 17 st ■, 20 st ■, 17 st ■, 15 st ■

- Cast-off sleeve 1 stitches.



(colors appear inverted from the instructions as this is the front view of the piece)

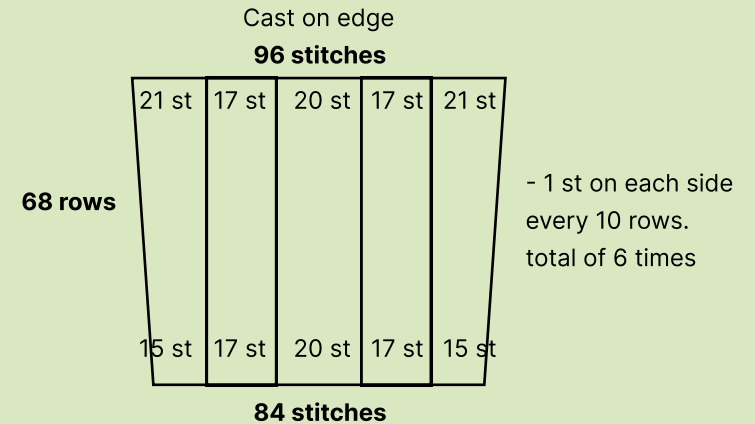


Sleeve 2

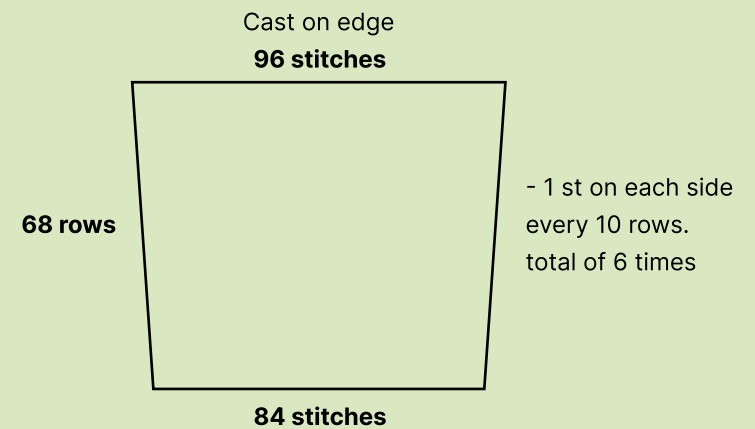
Simple sleeve

- Cast on 96 stitches using the 'e' wrap technique in background color ●
- Remove 1 stitch on each side every 10 rows. Knit until row 68. There should be a total of 84 stitches.
- Cast-off sleeve 2 stitches

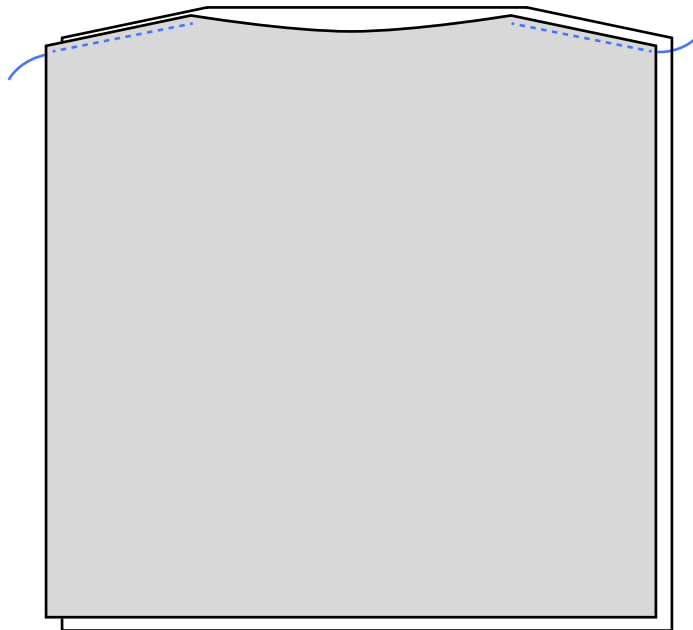

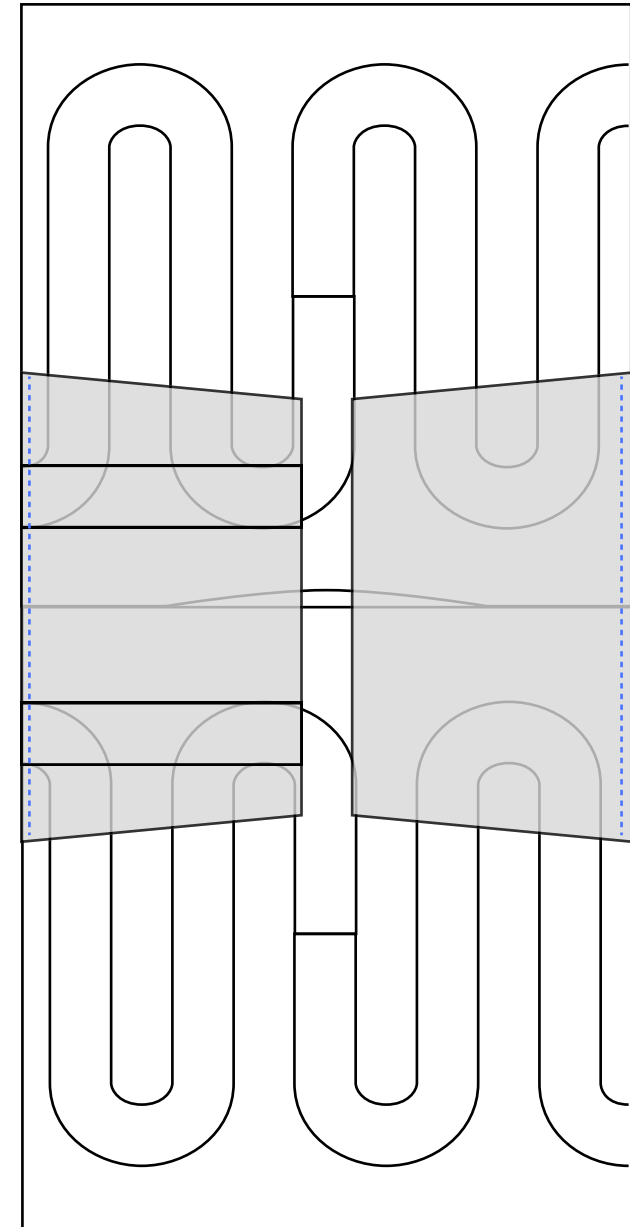
Assembly

Place the front and back pieces with their front sides together. Stitch the two pieces together through both shoulders to create the bodice.

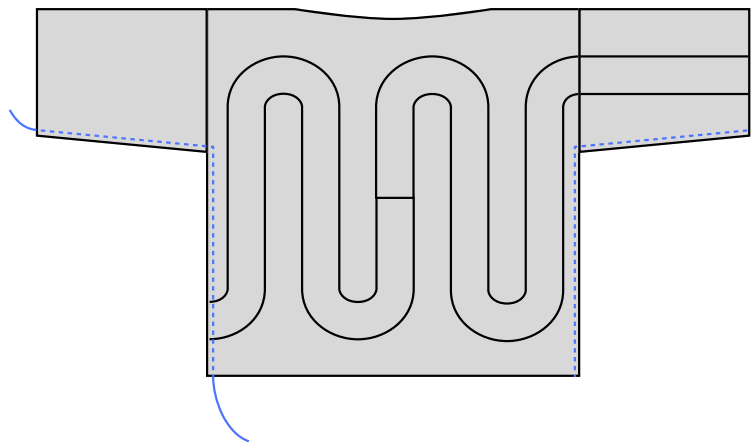


Open the bodice flat.

With front sides facing each other, stitch the sleeves into the bodice. (make sure the sleeve with the continuation of accent lines is placed on the correct side. Match the accent lines of the bodice with the ones on the sleeve).



Folding the tee inside out (with right sides facing each other), stitch the side of the bodice and the underarm in one go.



Finally, weave all loose ends and block the garment
